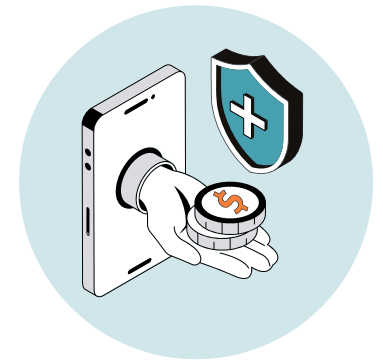


No Degree Required

Registered Nurses locally earn around **\$58–\$60 per hour**, and other roles in hospitals, clinics, labs, and community care also pay above the regional average.
