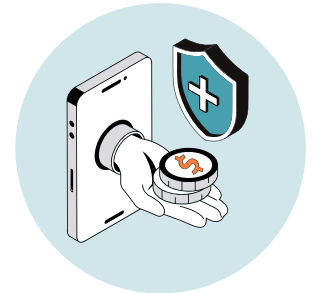


A Field Built for Growth
