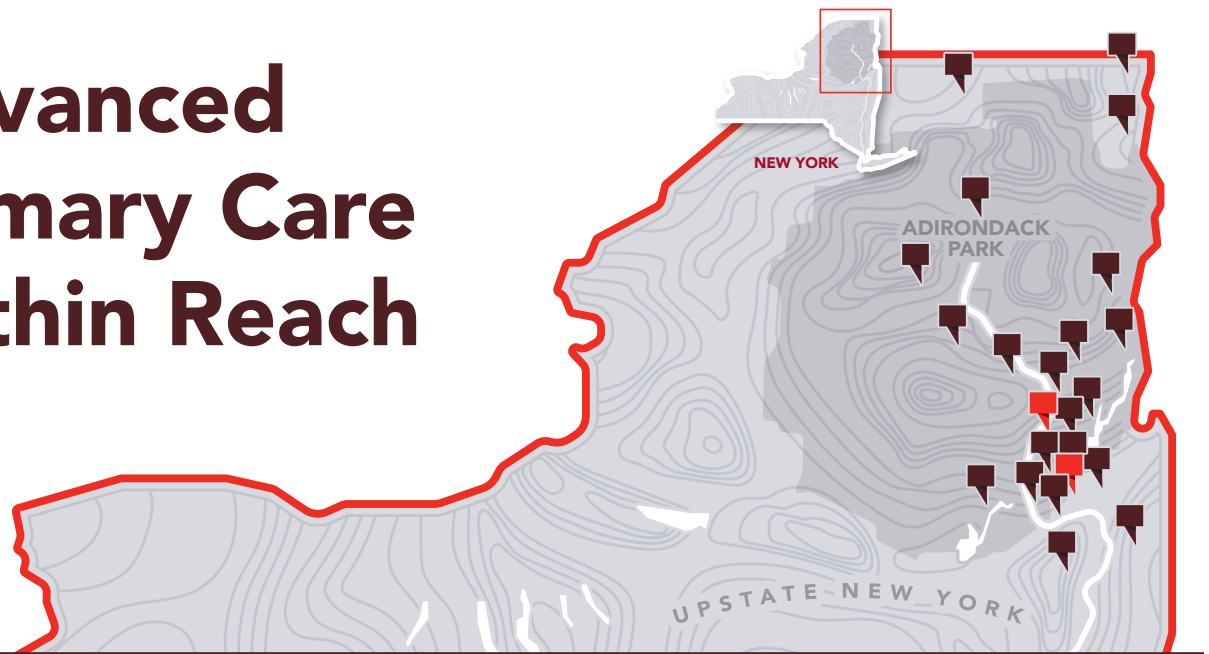

## SERVICES

- Comprehensive Primary Care: Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics
- Urgent Care
- Behavioral Health
- Obstetrics and Gynecology, Women's Health
