The Brave of Heart scholarship is honored to announce its next application cycle for family members of healthcare workers whose lives were lost in the fight against COVID-19. We want to make sure eligible applicants are aware of the approaching deadline, and that these scholarships are non-competitive.

All eligible applicants will receive some level of award.

Whether you are about to graduate from high school and head to college, considering continuing your education or registering for training that enhances your earning potential, the Brave of Heart Scholarship may be able to help. **Applications** are now being accepted online. Up to \$25,000.00 annually is available in funding, depending on an eligible applicant's academic focus, student status, and other criteria.

The Brave of Heart Scholarship will award scholarships through the 2026-27 school year. Individuals may also register to receive notification of future application cycles. This is especially important for children who are not eligible for funding yet, but will be in the future – or for others who might consider continuing their own education after this deadline.

Information for applicants:

- Applicants must be a spouse, domestic partner, or child of a healthcare worker, volunteer, or support staff whose life was lost in the fight against COVID-19
- Applicants need to have plans to enroll in an accredited program at a vocational and technical school, community college, 4-year college or university, or graduate school (if pursuing healthcare studies)
- Individuals enrolled in part-time coursework, returning to school for continuing education, or exploring a new field of study are eligible
- Individuals do not have to be previous recipients of Brave of Heart Fund grants; previous recipients of Brave of Heart grants are eligible
